In the next picture, you see where we are standing now here with the Lindane Legacy: we have the status of contaminated sites, you can see the EU regions active in the L Network, and the "HCH in EU" project, a great project where we have made a whole inventory of contaminated sites in the EU Member States, but we are still waiting that the Member States give some answers and do their homework after the termination of this project and that issue is also important to include in the Resolution. Then you see that we additionally made six Action Plans in six EU regions, which are

ready for actions to be taken and thus move forward, so there must come a follow-up! And this is what we have to fight for!



On the side the Obsolete and POPs Pesticides, where you can see that phantastic report we made on the strategy for the Central Asia region as part of EECCA countries (Eastern Europe, Caucasus, and Central Asian Republics), how to move forward, where we have explained when you invest now in the old Obsolete and POPs Pesticides for a period of 5-10 years and you have the necessary treatment equipment installed and working, thus the whole infrastructure is ready to tackle thereafter the new hazardous waste in these countries and we talk about millions of tons. Of course, the question was also what we are going to do with the region?
