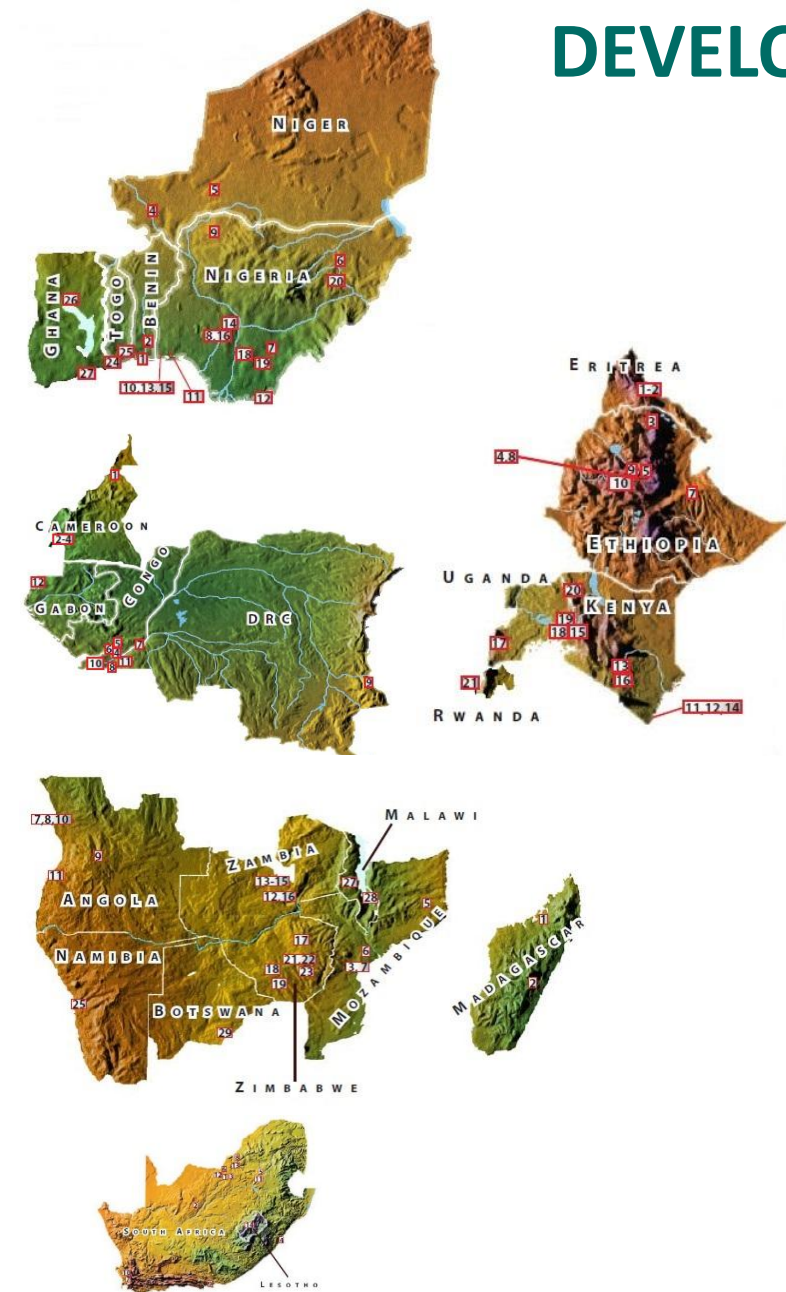


Common Problems
